What if 'special needs' kids were far more psychic, aware and talented than we currently acknowledge? These are just a few of the questions that Access True Knowledge is asking.

Access True Knowledge (ATK) facilitates a Foundation created to generate funding and implement Access Schools world-wide. Founders Gary Douglas and Dr. Dain Heer are seeking to have a system of education that empowers kids and acknowledges what they are great at, rather than dismissing them based on their weaknesses.

Douglas says that normal schools do not have the capacity to teach children like this, so they make it a problem and push them away. The only choice for parents then is to try and control the child with drugs like Ritalin, to keep them at school.

These kids can hear our thoughts. They function at speeds far beyond what we are used to using telepathy. For them, speaking is too slow; we are too slow.

They get frustrated because their parents are not listening and miss the communication. It's fast and as light as a feather. It just brushes across your mind.

ATK and Access Schools have a different point of view on education. They're asking, 'What if schools actually provided what the kids required, rather than asking the kids to provide what the school requires?' Could that begin to change and transform a system that is clearly not working for kids?
